



**Section 43 Placement – Appendix 2**

Regime/Access to facilities for Prisoners who are placed in separate confinement under s 43 of the [Prisons Act 1981](#)

a. Exercise and out of cell hours	Minimum of 1 hour daily. The minimum time allowed for taking air and exercise shall not include the time taken for carrying out normal daily routines (making the bed, going to the shower, and for ablutions, etc). May exercise with other prisoners similarly confined at the discretion of the Unit Manager.
b. Meals	In cell or as the superintendent /general manager directs, but separate from other prisoners.
c. Visits	Normal, but separate from other prisoners.
d. Gratuities	At the discretion of the designated Superintendent /General Manager Acacia.
e. Spends	At the discretion of designated Superintendent / General Manager Acacia but separate from other prisoners.
f. Showers	Normal prison routine but separate from other prisoners. Unit Manager may approve extra access.
g. Religion	May receive visits from Chaplain or in accordance with s 53 of the <i>Prisons Act 1981</i> .
h. Medical/offender treatment programs	Normal access. Review by health staff and, where available, by offender program staff as soon as practicable after placement. Regular, preferably daily, review by health staff and, where available, by offender program staff. At discretion of superintendent /general manager, access may be in sight of but out of hearing of an officer .
i. Mail	Normal receipt and dispatch.
j. Clothing	Normal prison issue. Unit Manager may approve extra clothing
k. Movements	Under escort of an officer
l. Reading Materials	Normal prison routine. The Unit Manager may approve extra access to library items
m. Writing Materials	Normal access
n. Radio/Cassette/Television	Normal access to personal radio, television etc. Unit Manager may approve extra access

o. Cell Furniture	Normal. Unit Manager may approve extra furniture
p. Hobby Materials	Yes, at request of prisoner, and at the discretion of the Unit Manager
q. Study Material	Yes, at request of prisoner
r. Work	Yes, where practicable, but separate from other prisoners
s. Leave of Absence	Leave of absence under s 83 of the <i>Prisons Act 1981</i> available (refer to Adult Custodial Rule 16).
t. Lights Out	Normal
u. Telephone Access	Normal access.
v. Daily Timetable	To be determined by the designated Superintendent / General Manager Acacia.
w. Canteen Goods	Normal prison routine. The Unit Manager may approve extra access.
x. Property In Storage	Normal access to reading material or papers relating to his conviction or pending court proceedings. All other access at the discretion of the Unit Manager .
