Jurisdiction	Sentence	Authority
Western Australia	Finite term (without parole)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> None required. Release on expiration of term. Re-entry release order provisions. Where re-entry release has been denied, prisoner is eligible for early discharge.
	Parole term	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Release can only be granted by a Parole order or re-entry release order issued by the Prisoners Review Board. Prisoners must be released on expiration of term if there is no other order for release issued before that date. Where parole has been denied, prisoner is not eligible for early discharge.
	Fixed term less than 12 months and eligible for Short Term parole	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Release on Short Term parole if parole granted If prisoner is denied Short Term parole they must be released at expiration of term. Where parole has been denied, prisoner is not eligible for early discharge.
Federal	Parole	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Commonwealth parole order. If not released on parole or re-entry release, must be released on expiration of term Where Commonwealth parole has been denied, prisoner is not eligible for early discharge. (Ensure the prisoner is not also serving a State sentence, requiring a State parole order)
	Recognisance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must have a signed recognisance order by prisoner. If not released on Recognisance or re-entry release, must be released on expiration of term If Recognisance order not signed, prisoner is not eligible for early discharge
	Finite	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> None required. Release on expiration of term. Eligible for early discharge.
Joint Federal and State	Parole/recognisance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Must have both relevant orders. If both denied, not eligible for early discharge.
Interstate		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Upon transfer, interstate sentence is deemed to have been imposed by a WA Court. Therefore the WA conditions set out above apply.

Expiration of term means EDR, MAX date or EXP (juvenile) as applicable.
